Knight Vision PeopleSoft Retrofit Project Overview

This program is an effort to ensure UCF meets all critical PeopleSoft functions, processes and bolt-on applications to enable continued critical business operations in Campus Solutions (student information system) at Go-Live for Workday HCM and FIN applications. This project encapsulates the retrofitting of all student-related functionality, the moving and retrofitting HCM, CRM, Integration Hub, & Bolt-on application functionality within Campus Solutions as well as mandatory reporting to Board of Governors.



Knight Vision PeopleSoft Retrofit Project Overview

- Continue to provide student services to ~72,000 students
- Ability to integrate data between PeopleSoft and Workday, and other existing applications
- Manage the activity, promotion and other services for ~2,000 faculty & staff
- Continue mandatory state reporting



PeopleSoft Applications Code Freeze



October 15, 2021 Code Freeze Alert

In July 2022, UCF will replace PeopleSoft financials, human resources and grants administration applications with Workday, a modern, cloud-based enterprise resource planning (ERP) platform.

In our current PeopleSoft environment, integrations exist between our PeopleSoft student system and the PeopleSoft human resources and finance systems. As we move to Workday HR and Finance, the UCF IT team will be replacing current PeopleSoft integrations with the new Workday HR and Finance modules prior to the new Workday system going live in July 2022.

To ensure we have a stable system and adequate development team availability to complete the necessary transition between now and our go-live in July 2022, the PeopleSoft development teams will be administering a code freeze beginning October 15, 2021, for PeopleSoft human resources, finance and student systems software. Exceptions to this freeze will be limited to compliance and regulatory changes and updates necessary for bug fixes and maintenance.

In Summary:

- As of October 15, the PeopleSoft development teams will be administering a code freeze on all PeopleSoft systems requests, with the exception of compliance, regulatory and break/fix code changes.
- Requests for PeopleSoft systems code modifications will be put on hold until after the Workday go-live, planned for July 2022.

What is a PeopleSoft Retrofit?

Any change to the existing PeopleSoft Systems (Campus Solutions, Portal, CRM) to support the Workday HCM/FIN Implementation, including but not limited to, integrations, processes, and data.



Campus Solutions is integrated with both Human Capital Management and Financials Systems and heavily relies on their data. **With the Workday Implementation, this will change!**

Student data will reside in Campus Solutions.

Employee and Financial data will reside in Workday.

All Processes & Reports currently using both student and employee data will need to be analyzed and retrofitted

All Processes & Reports using Financials' Chart of Account data will need to be analyzed and retrofitted

All objects using Database Links need to be analyzed and retrofitted

All objects using Database Links need to be analyzed and retrofitted to only pull data from CS

Retrofits in myUCF/Integration Hub

Changes on July 1, 2022

Disappear

Staff Applications > Human Capital Management

Links to HCMPROD backdoor no longer possible

Employee Self Service

No more employee bio demo, payroll, etc. actions directly accessed from myUCF

Manager Self Service

Similarly, no more managerial actions will be processed from myUCF

New

Staff Applications > Workday

New links will be available to access Workday for all employees to continue performing their regular self-service and payroll actions

SnapLogic Moving to Informatica

During the PeopleSoft Workday Retrofit Cycle, one of our current integration products will also be transitioning to a new tool which has a near go-live date with Workday.

Proofs of concept are underway covering a wide area of current connectivity points.

The migration will not be all at once, and the SnapLogic systems will still be processing during this transition period.

Required	Conditionally Required	Few Currently Unused
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Chartfield	Comments
Business Unit	Legal entity
Department	Represent specific units of operations - First through fourth digits = Functional area and Department - Fifth digit = Funding source - Sixth digit = Based on fifth - Seventh through eighth digits = Specific departmental number
Fund Code	Represents source/pool of funds -First digit = External Fund - Second digit = Department or a Project - Third through fifth digits = Financial Statement Code / Other Cost Accumulator (OCA)
Program Code*	Classify functional purpose of transactions
Account	Classify the nature of a financial transaction
Alternate Account	Higher level rollup Defaulted from Account

Chartfield	Intended Use
PC Business Unit	Classify Projects into categories like Grants, Auxiliary, Construction
Project	Unit of operation, with specific start and end date
Activity	Specific tasks that make up a project Can Budget at Activity level
Analysis Type	Identify different types of Project transactions
Budget Reference	Used to identify budget year

*Driver Worktags

Required

Worktag	Comments
Company	Legal entity with separate tax ID and a balanced set of books (UCF, DSOs) - Balancing segment
Fund	Represents source/pool of funds primarily used to track spending restrictions - Balancing Worktag - Budget Controlled
Division	High level, visible roll up level within the org structure. Broader than our divisions today - Balancing Worktag - Budget Controlled
Cost Center*	Unit with an ongoing business purpose within the institution, budget, positioned employees, and generally occupies space. Generally synonymous with “department” today. - Budget Controlled - Fund Balance
Program	To classify functional purpose of transactions. Aligns with NACUBO and State Reporting Needs
Financial Site	High level ‘location’ worktag

Conditionally Required

Worktag	Intended Use
Gift*	Worktag associated with endowed and spendable gifts. Conditionally required based on fund. - Budget controlled - Fund Balance
Grant*	Worktag associated with sponsored funding (e.g. Grants). Required to be associated with an Award. Conditionally required based on fund. - Budget controlled - Fund Balance
Project*	Specific begin and end dates that may cross fiscal years. Used for Capital Projects, IT Projects, RF Licenses & Incubator Programs, Carryforward Plans. Additional use cases still TBD. - Budget controlled - Fund Balance
Designation*	Used to capture smaller buckets of <u>designated</u> funds (e.g. PI Funds, Start-Up, Balance Accounts) - Budget controlled - Fund Balance

Optional

Worktag	Intended Use
Financial Initiative	Formal/Informal Inter-Departmental Initiatives - Optionally Budgeted but not Controlled - Fund balance
Activity	Departmental Use - Optionally Budgeted but not Controlled - No Fund balance
Specialty	Indicates a field of medicine a provider is billing. Worktag to be used by our Health entities.
Provider	Delineates physician, nurse practitioner, and fellow. Worktag to be used by our Health entities.

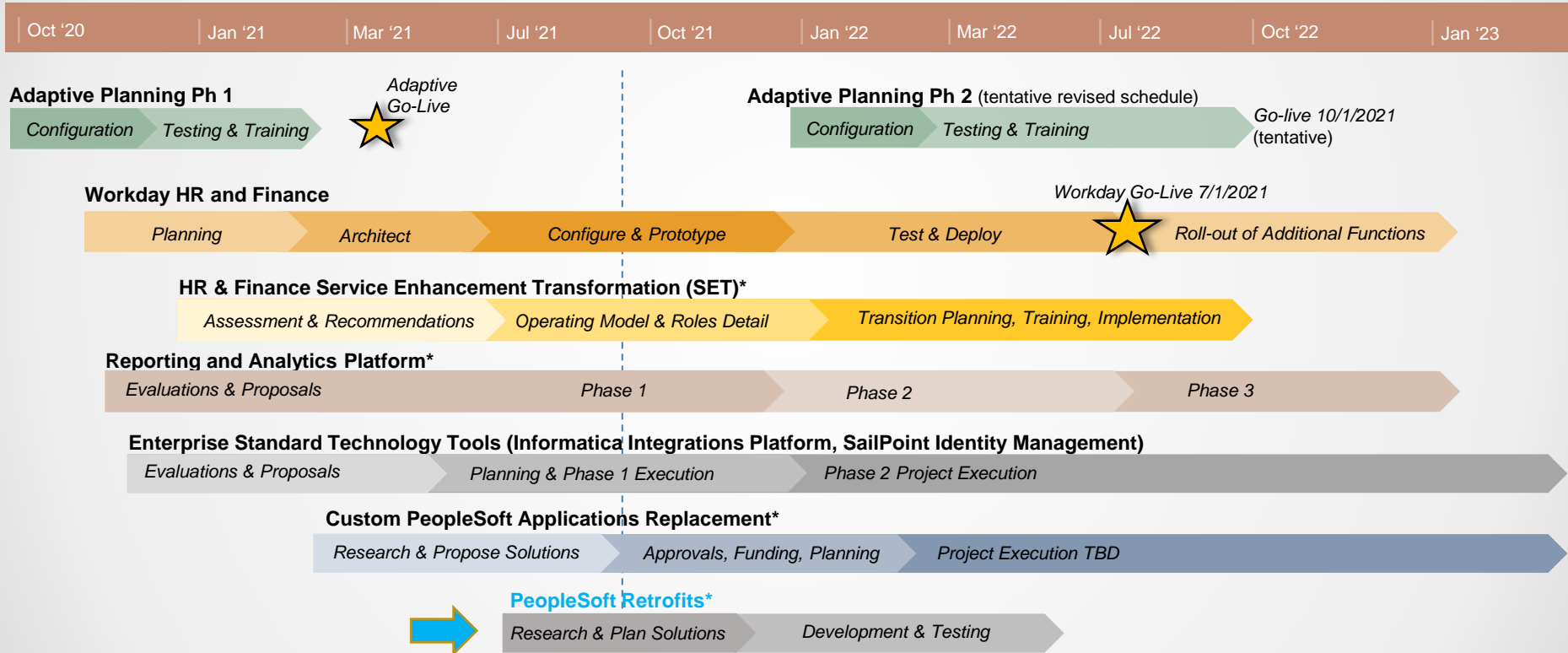

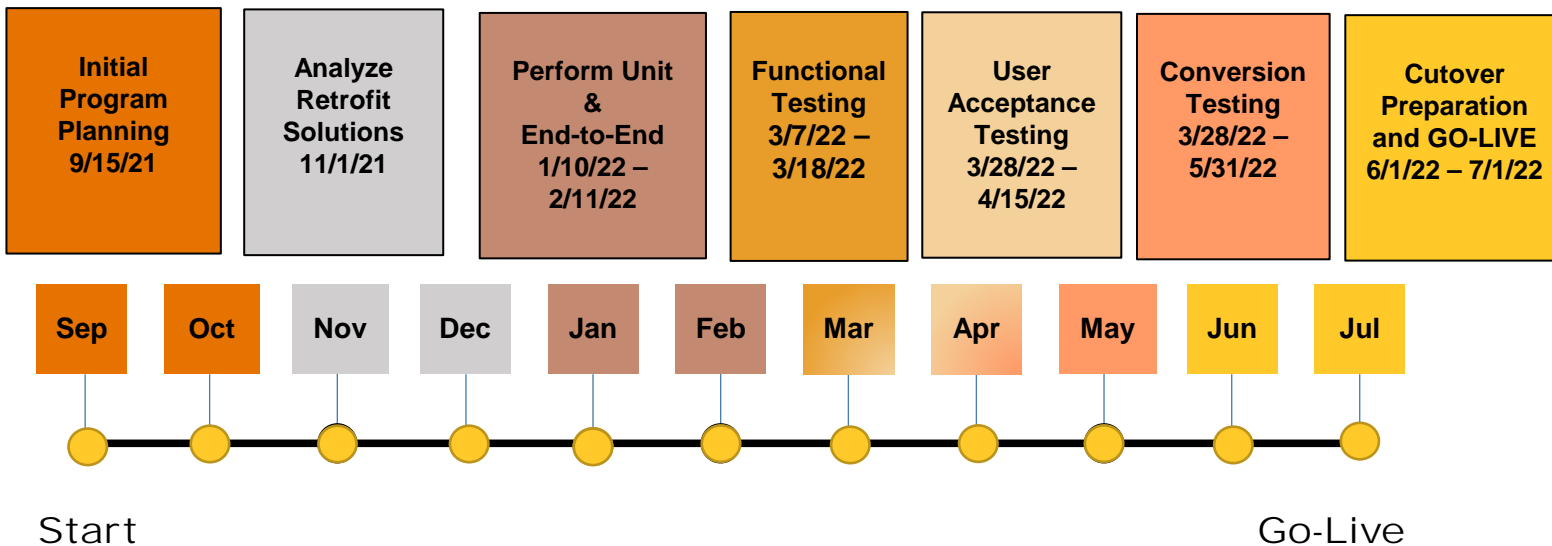
Knight Vision Program Timeline

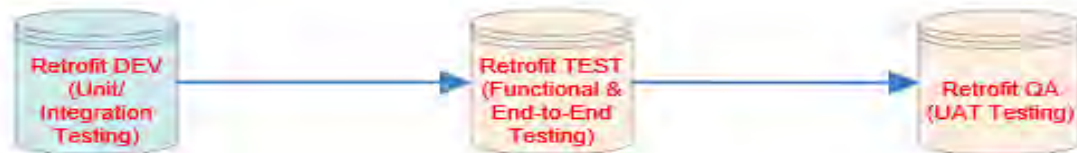

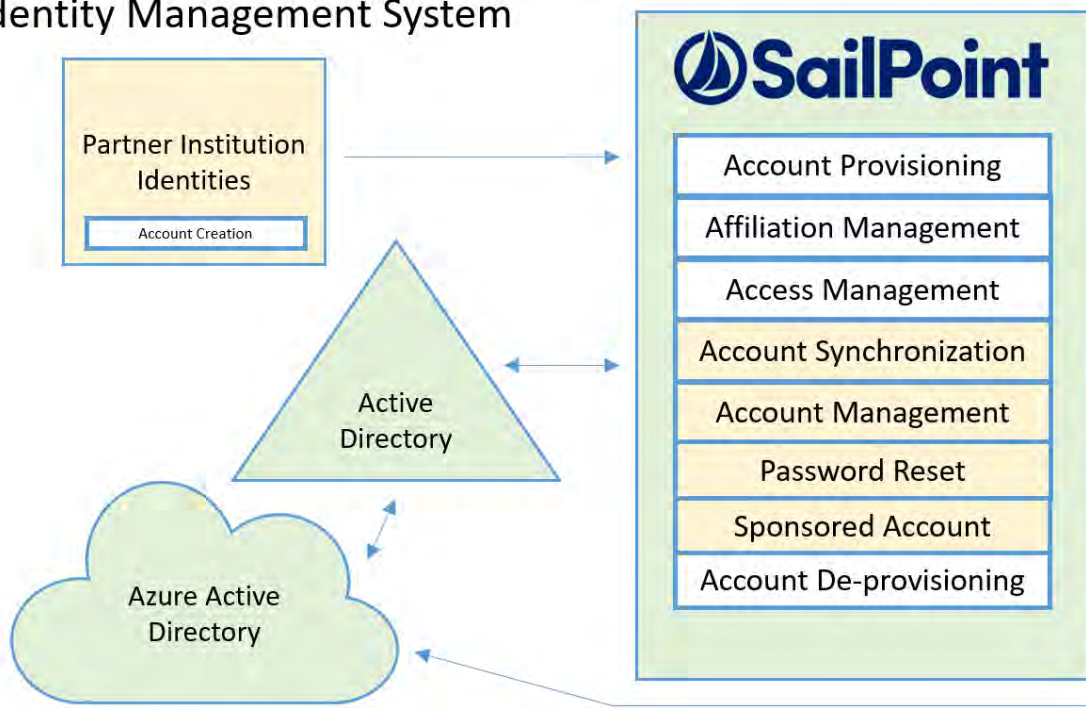

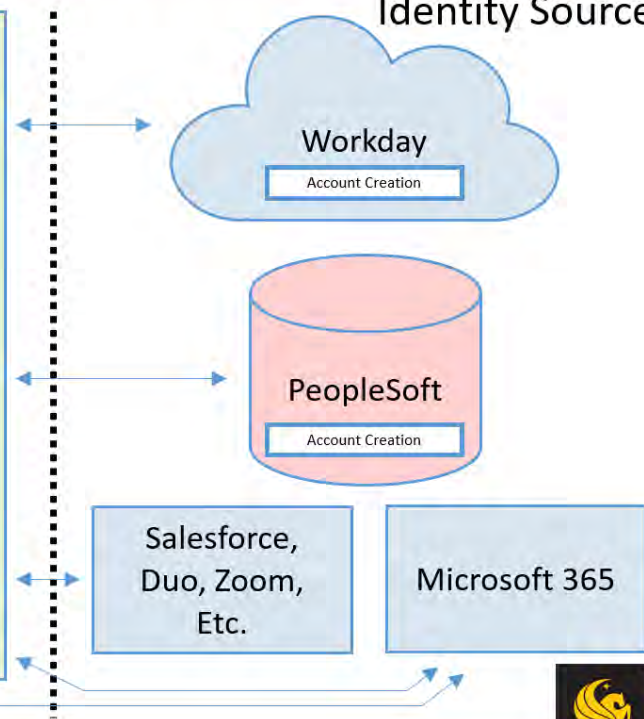
